Welcome to the 2021 Oklahoma Wholesale Marketers Association Annual Conference, and thank you for your commitment to serving as the bridge between manufacturers and retailers bringing vital products needed by communities during the critical times of the last year. Looking back at last year's CDA Industry Outlook survey, distributors understandably predicted a strong economic outlook and business as usual in 2020. 



She is a student worker in WKU's Modern Language Department and has worked at Los Barrios.






















